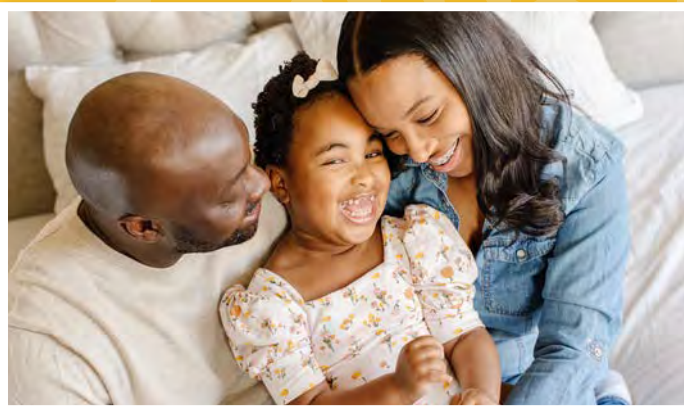


2022 Giving Opportunities

**“It’s all been
done for me.”**



In 2019, Aidan was in a very serious car accident. He lost his younger sister and the use of the lower half of his body. His spinal cord injuries required a lot of time and medical attention. He needed a stable environment and Tamatha, his grandmother, stepped up to give him the care he needed. She started searching for options. She was “looking more towards recovery rather than just accepting the fact that he was in a wheelchair.”

Tamatha found Frazier Rehab's unique therapy programs here in Louisville, KY. Aidan started intensive treatment in September 2020 and soon, both Tamatha and Aidan saw a difference. Frazier's special techniques gave Aidan a huge boost in confidence. He could tell he had responses below his injuries, giving him encouragement, and giving them both a lot of hope. While Aidan received therapy at Frazier, he and Tamatha “developed a normal routine at our Ronald McDonald House – just like at a regular house.”

Tamatha said: “Being able to do laundry, have normal meals, a normal routine with school – it is a sense of balance.” Tamatha told us that at a hotel, the need for wheelchair access, access to food, to store and cook food, things like that become far more complicated. “Anything that I need is here and if I need help with something, all I have to do is ask...It takes the load off with the worry that it takes to try and figure that all out...it’s all been done for me.”

She continued: “There's only one me and there's only so much energy in a day. I would not be capable of doing all that without the support that I've gotten here. The staff has been wonderful. We feel like we've got friends – more than just people that work here. They feel like an extended family. Some days are more difficult than others. Just having that friendly smile and that extra encouragement, somebody asking how your day is going. It's just me and him and we're doing this 24/7. Some days that means everything in the world to have that kind of support. It really does. It's more than I could have ever expected. I'm very, very grateful. Without RMHCK's support, it wouldn't be possible otherwise. It means everything to be able to help in his recovery.”

Tamatha and Aidan stayed with us for 186 nights, leaving in April 2021 to return home to New Concord, KY.

Families who must travel to Louisville to seek healthcare for their seriously ill children will find a haven at our 56 guestroom Ronald McDonald House. We serve families who reside outside of Jefferson County, KY, and Floyd and Clark Counties, IN, who have children ages 21 or younger receiving medical care in the Louisville area. Staffed 24 hours, 365 days a year, we're just a few blocks from Norton Children's Hospital and other medical facilities. We relieve families of stressors and financial worries by providing:

- private guestrooms and bathrooms with linens and toiletries
- stocked kitchens
- home-cooked meals and snacks
- laundry facilities
- comfortable living rooms
- indoor and outdoor play areas
- organized activities
- internet access
- free parking

With the help of our medical partners, RMHCK provides dedicated rooms inside hospitals to ensure families have a quiet place to rest only steps from their children. Family Rooms can be found at Norton Children's Hospital, Frazier Rehab Institute, and Norton Women's and Children's Hospital. Amenities vary at each facility, but can include sleep rooms, restrooms with showers, laundry facilities, comfortable living rooms, and stocked kitchens.
