



Health & Safety Guidelines

To provide the safest possible experience for all of our guests, staff, and volunteers, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Kentuckiana (RMHCK) is adhering to the following health & safety precautions for the Red Tie Gala:

- We require all guests, staff, volunteers, and contractors to be fully vaccinated, including the booster shot, or show proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours. If you have not received your COVID-19 booster shot by February 19, 2022, then you will need to show proof of a negative COVID-19 test.
- Masks will be optional for the event.
- We are taking advantage of the spacious Grand Ballroom at the Galt House by allowing ample space between dining tables.
- We are working with the Galt House to ensure CDC cleaning procedures are followed and that hand sanitizer stations will be set up throughout the event space.

As things are rapidly changing, we will constantly revisit our guidelines to ensure the highest safety measures are in place and communicate changes with attendees.

Please enjoy our virtual Red Tie Gala at Home if you:

- Have had a fever of 100.4 or higher in the 10 days prior to March 5, 2022.
- Are sick, have been diagnosed with COVID-19, or have exhibited any cold or flu-like symptoms in the 10 days prior to March 5, 2022.
- Have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Do not feel comfortable attending an in-person event.
